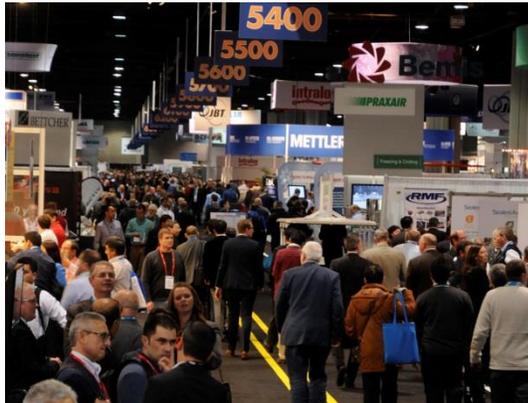

TSNN Recognizes International Production & Processing Expo Among Top 50 US Trade Shows



Tucker, Ga. – April 15, 2015 – After completing a record-breaking year, the International Production & Processing Expo (IPPE) is pleased to announce its recognition by Trade Show News Network (TSNN) as ranking 48th on the 2014 TSNN Top 250 Trade Show List in terms of net square footage. This ranking has also made IPPE eligible to be one of TSNN's Top 50 fastest growing shows. IPPE, which is sponsored by the U.S. Poultry & Egg Association (USPOULTRY), the American Feed Industry Association (AFIA) and the North American Meat Institute (NAMI), will be honored at the sixth annual TSNN awards, Nov. 6-8, in Atlanta, Ga.

The 2016 IPPE will take place Tuesday through Thursday, Jan. 26 – 28, at the Georgia World Congress Center in Atlanta, Ga.
