

Rice Lake Showcases Washdown Scales for Meat and Feed Production at IPPE 2019

Rice Lake, Wis.—Rice Lake Weighing Systems will demonstrate washdown production solutions at the International Production and Processing Expo (IPPE), at the Georgia World Congress Center in Atlanta, February 12-14, 2019. Visitors to booth B6153 will see Rice Lake's extreme washdown BenchMark™ HE-X and RoughDeck® QC-X scales.

The BenchMark HE-X bench scale and RoughDeck QC-X floor scale are designed to meet strict sanitary design principles to provide the ultimate washdown capability. Both scale frames are made from solid 304 stainless steel beams connected with continuous welds to ensure a hygienic environment in meat and feed processing facilities.

The BenchMark HE-X has a stacked frame for ruggedness. The upper frame supports the removeable cover and the lower frame is connected to the adjustable, non-slip feet. An IP69K hermetically sealed load cell is protected during high-pressure washing.

The RoughDeck QC-X has a top deck that opens 75 degrees so the entire scale interior can be washed and sanitized. Four stainless steel, welded seal, IP69K load cells are used with PTFE cable for safety in steam cleaning and washdown areas.
